



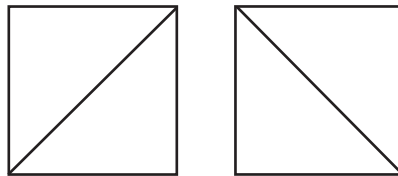
E unit

- Cut 4 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles from medium/dark fabric.
- Cut 8 - 2 1/2" squares from light fabric.

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Draw a diagonal line on the back of each 2 1/2" square. Place 1 - 2 1/2" square at each end of the 10 1/2" rectangle. Stitch directly on the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4". Discard trimmed fabric. Press open to produce an E unit. Repeat for the other 4 rectangles.

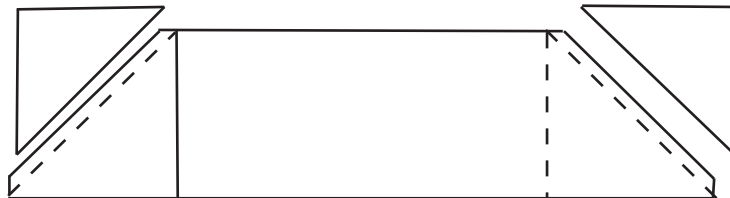
Step 1: Draw diagonal line on each medium/dark 2 1/2" square.



Step 2: Place 2 1/2" squares on each end of one of the rectangles, right sides together. Stitch on the diagonal line.



Step 3: Allowing a 1/4" seam allowance, trim away excess fabric. Discard excess fabric.



Step 4: Press seam open towards the dark triangle to produce a E unit. Repeat for the remaining 3 rectangles and 6



F Unit

- Cut 4 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles from light fabric.
- Cut 8 - 2 1/2" squares from medium/dark fabric.

Repeat steps 1-4 to produce 4 - F units. Press towards light triangles.

Following diagram on page 1 of instructions, sew all elements of the block together.
